Please be advised the Ontario & Western Railway Historical Society, Inc. is the owner of the trademark and logo for the name New York, Ontario & Western Railway, Inc. for use on publications and printed matter, namely newsletters, tour guides and archival reprints, all relating to railroad history; hats, collectable toy trains and parts and accessories thereof; promoting and conducting tradeshow exhibitions in the field of railroad history; temporary retail stores set up at trade shows featuring books, publications, souvenirs, hats and memorabilia concerning railroad history and promoting public awareness of railroad history and railroad historical societies; for organizing and conducting excursions along the remaining rights of way of historical railroads; for conducting educational programs and exhibitions featuring slide shows, presentations, artifacts and memorabilia in the field of railroad history. This trademark is registered with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office.

As a result, the use of the New York, Ontario & Western Railway, Inc. trademark and / or logo on factory produced publications and printed matter, namely newsletters, tour guides and archival reprints, all relating to railroad history; hats, collectable toy trains and parts and accessories thereof; promoting and conducting tradeshow exhibitions in the field of railroad history; temporary retail stores set up at trade shows featuring books, publications, souvenirs, hats and memorabilia concerning railroad history and promoting public awareness of railroad history and railroad historical societies; for organizing and conducting excursions along the remaining rights of way of historical railroads; for conducting educational programs and exhibitions featuring slide shows, presentations, artifacts and memorabilia in the field of railroad history will require that a license be acquired from the Ontario & Western Railway Society, Inc.

We do not intend to levy burdensome requirements on bona fide manufacturers for use of the New York, Ontario & Western Railway Inc. trademark and logo on their publications and printed matter, namely newsletters, tour guides and archival reprints, all relating to railroad history; hats, collectable toy trains and parts and accessories thereof; promoting and conducting tradeshow exhibitions in the field of railroad history; temporary retail stores set up at trade shows featuring books, publications, souvenirs, hats and memorabilia concerning railroad history and promoting public awareness of railroad history and railroad historical societies; for organizing and conducting excursions along the remaining rights of way of historical railroads; for conducting educational programs and exhibitions featuring slide shows, presentations, artifacts and memorabilia in the field of railroad history that will use the New York, Ontario & Western Railway, Inc. name, trademark and /or logo. You should immediately contact the Ontario & Western Railway Historical Society, Inc. so that arrangements can be made for the issuance of the appropriate license for your product.
